## About the role

We're currently welcoming people who are looking to volunteer with us at several workshops during the Spring and Summer terms, and potentially beyond into the next academic year. We run programmes across London, and our workshops always take place during the school day, normally lasting around 2 hours.

We ask that workshop volunteers:

- Assist with on-the-day workshop preparation and clearing up
- Give support to any of the residents with additional needs (e.g. hearing difficulties, mobility issues, memory loss etc.)
- Get involved with the workshop activities (joining in games, assisting the facilitator, helping pupils with reading and writing etc.)

At InCommon we believe in creating educational experiences across generations. We hope everyone learns something new at our workshops (and we always do!)
